Ashland Police Seek Assistance Identifying Credit Card Fraud Suspects

The Ashland Police Department is seeking the community's assistance identifying the individuals pictured below who are suspects in the use of a stolen credit card at the Walmart in the 100 block of South Hill Carter Parkway in Ashland.

On Thursday, February 7, 2019 at approximately 2:40 a.m., the two individuals entered the store and purchased items at a self-checkout lane with the stolen card. They exited and left the store in a white, four-door sedan, also depicted below. The credit card used was stolen from a vehicle in the area of Ashland Towne Square in the 300 block of Silversmith Court sometime after 8:00 p.m. that evening on February 6.
