Ashland PD Charges Driver in Vehicle, Train Collision

On Thursday, January 19, 2023, Ashland police investigators charged Lizzeth Calderon Henriquez with misdemeanor hit and run, operating a vehicle without a driver's license, and operating a vehicle without insurance for the accidental collision with a CSX train at the England Street crossing occurring on Sunday, January 15, 2023.

Subsequent to an investigation, it was determined that there was no intentional effort on the part of the driver to damage or interfere with train operations or critical infrastructure.

The Ashland PD would like to thank the public for their patience throughout the investigation to resolve this incident.

Ashland PD Investigates Vehicle, Train Collision

On Sunday, January 15, 2023, at approximately 3:27 a.m., the Ashland Police Department responded to the railroad tracks at the intersection of England Street and Railroad Avenue for a report of a single-vehicle collision with a train. The vehicle involved was traveling westbound when it proceeded through the railroad crossing as the crossing arms were coming down. The driver was able to exit the vehicle before a train travelling southbound struck the vehicle. The driver fled the scene on foot westbound on Thompson Street.
